ONTARIO, Calif., Jan. 30, 2006 – The DeAeth Family of Washington, Tex., which owns and operates True Blue Animal Rescue, a non-profit organization that provides a safe haven for neglected horses, dogs and other animals, are the proud owners of a brand-new barn thanks to MD Enterprises, Inc. of Ontario, Calif. and ABC Television's "*EXTREME MAKEOVER: HOME EDITION*".

In an episode that ran on Sunday, January 29 at 8/7c on ABC Television, "*EXTREME MAKEOVER: HOME EDITION*" headed to the Texas ranch owned by the DeAeths, where it changed the lives of this special family and their rescued animals, re-building the family home and providing them with much-needed shelter for the dogs, horses and other animals that reside on the ranch while awaiting adoption.

To assist this family in providing temporary housing for the horses that await adoption on the DeAeth ranch, MD Enterprises, Inc. donated a 10-stall gable barn with porch, featuring nine stalls and one tack room. MD Enterprises' use of fire resistant materials, coupled with exceptional durability, provides the DeAeth family assurance that their barn can withstand all of the elements including rain, snow, sleet and even extreme heat.
